Strengthening the role of RTOs supporting industry & society in the post-pandemic era

Highlights 2022



- EARTO positioned RTOs as key actors of the EU twin green & digital transitions
- EARTO successfully developed and promoted EARTO 19 publications, including position papers thanks to its 7 Working Groups' expertise (i.e. coordination more than 500 experts)
- EARTO promoted RTOs participation in EU RD&I programmes: Horizon Europe, Digital Europe, Regional, Space & Defence Programmes
- EARTO participated in European Research Area (ERA) Forum and promoted RTOs as key RD&I actors
- EARTO supported the European Parliament in securing investments in RD&I on 2023 EU Budget
- EARTO continued its collaborations with key RD&I actors:
 - Publishing with OECD a Joint Study on the contribution of RTOs to socio-economic recovery, resilience and transitions
 - Publishing with EC DG JRC a Joint Report on Technology Infrastructures
 - Answering to the EC Consultations on Horizon Europe Interim Evaluation & Horizon 2020 Final Evaluation
 - Publishing with ASTP, Aurora Universities, Coimbra Group, EU-LIFE, The Guild, IDEA League & LERU a Joint Statement on the MGA IP Provisions of the EIC under Horizon Europe
 - Co-chairing the Industry-RTOs Informal Group on RD&I framework programme with Business Europe and DIGITALEUROPE comprising 30+ EU sectoral industrial associations to promote the role of applied RD&I in EU framework programmes
 - Sponsoring a new IDEA Consult report on the review of the impact assessment studies of RTOs
- EARTO organised several key events with EU Representatives enabling its members to discuss key EU topics with EU Institutions
- EARTO Working Group Space launched into a new stand-alone association EASTRO



EARTO Members' Participation in Horizon Europe - Until end November 2022

EARTO members strongly contributing to Horizon Europe

EARTO members received **8,6%** of **HE EU funding**

While EARTO members only represent **1,1%** of all HE beneficiaries

Respectively 8% and 1% in H2020

Projects involving at least one EARTO member received 51% of HE EU funding

Respectively 44% in H2020

25% of all HE projects includes at least one EARTO member

Respectively 15% in H2020

EARTO Members' Participation in Horizon Europe - 2

EARTO members fostering industry participation in Horizon Europe projects

The average industrial involvement in HE projects increases to

36% when EARTO members are involved in the project

from 27% when they are not part of the consortium

Respectively 34% and 24% in H2020

EARTO members involved in large multi-stakeholders' collaborative projects

HE projects with EARTO members receive

on average €6,2m of EC funding in HE

While the average EU funding per project in HE is €3m

Respectively €4,8m and €1,7m in H2020

HE projects with EARTO members count

16 partners on average per project in HE

While the overall average in HE is **8** partners per project

Respectively 12 and 3 in H2020
